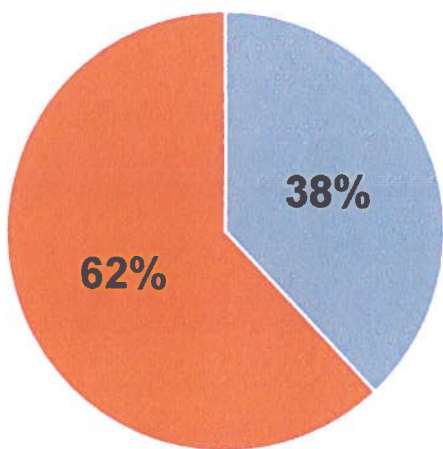

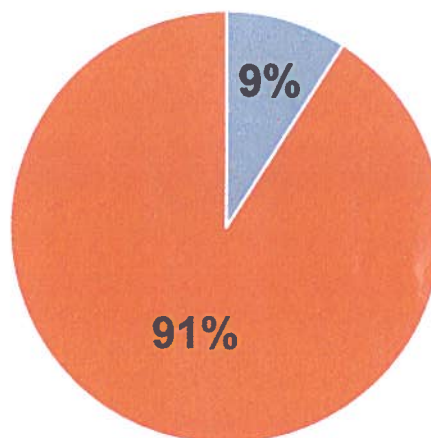

LCAP Guidelines

Meaningful engagement of parents, pupils, and other stakeholders, including those representing economically disadvantaged, English learners and foster youth subgroups, is critical to the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) and Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP). Stakeholders specified in this plan are: Certificated Staff Members, WSCATA, Support Staff Members, CSEA, Confidential Staff / Supervisors, Administrators / Management, School Board, Students, Parent Advisory Group / Site Council, Low Income Advisory Group, Foster Youth Advisory Group, and English Learner Advisory Group.

LCAP Priority Areas

Priority 1: Basis Services

Proper teacher credentialing, appropriate teacher assignments, adequate standards-based instructional materials, school facilities kept in good repair

Priority 2: Implementation of Common Core State Standards

Degree to which Common Core content and performance standards are implemented for all students

Priority 3: Parent Involvement and Input

Efforts to seek parent input in decision making; promotion of parent participation in programs for low income students, English learners, Foster youth, and students with special needs

Priority 4: Student Achievement

Performance on standardized tests, API scores, share of pupils who are college and career ready, share of English learners who become English proficient, English learner reclassification rates, Advanced Placement pass rates, Early Assessment Program pass rates, other local measures

Priority 5: Student Engagement

School attendance rates, chronic absenteeism rates, dropout rates, graduation rates, other local measures

Priority 6: School Climate

Pupil suspension and expulsion rates, stakeholders' sense of school safety and school connectedness, other local measures

Priority 7: Course Access

Enrollment of pupils in broad course of study that includes all core subject areas

Priority 8: Other Student Outcomes

Measures locally defined (for example, student transfer rates)
