**Re: REPORT ON FACILITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS, SUMMER 2013**

**The following facility improvement projects were completed during Summer 2013 or are in process as of this date, funded with Measure I Bond revenues, developer fees, facility use fees, and / or the general fund maintenance budget.**

- Analy/El Molino Restrooms (Contractor - AE Nelson Construction, Project Manager - Counterpoint): Wall covering, flooring, water and light fixtures, partitions, dispensers, and painting will be complete by the opening of school. Janitor sink and floor in Analy cafeteria was also repaired. Remaining restroom improvements can be completed next summer, without working during the school year.
- Analy Outdoor Drinking Fountains (Contractor - AE Nelson Construction, Project Manager - Counterpoint): New fountains should be installed before school opens.
- El Molino Science Rooms (Service providers – various, Project Managers Counterpoint and District): Blinds, dishwashers, and electrical for the new El Molino Makerspace should be completed before school starts.
- El Molino Well (Service providers – various, Project Manager - Counterpoint): Local providers are planning storage and connections to the El Molino irrigation systems. District will need to decide when and how to move forward after cost estimates are received (approximately September 1).
- Analy/El Molino/Laguna Emergency Gas Seismic Shutoff Valves (Contractor - AE Nelson Construction, Project Manager - Counterpoint): Valves installed. Waiting for final inspection and approval before turning on. Expect completion before school starts.
- Analy Ventilation Project (Contractor - AE Nelson Construction, Project Manager - Counterpoint): Electrical and ceiling fans have been installed. Intake and exhaust fans are next to be installed. Expect completion before school starts.
- Analy Clock Tower Repair (Contractor - AE Nelson Construction, Project Manager - Counterpoint): District approved replacing exterior, repairing trim, eliminating bird entry holes, and painting clock tower. Structural damage discovered when exterior boards were removed. Engineer called in; report and recommendations expected by August 9. Work may not be complete before school starts.

- Security Camera Project (Service Provider - Decotech, Project Manager - Counterpoint): District approved installation of new system at all schools. Expect completion before school starts.
  
- Assorted Improvements (Project Manager - District):
  - Paint various high-use areas at all school (summer paint crew)
  - Paint stairway railings and safety paint steps inside AHS mail building
  - Paint EHS library exterior
  - Replace or repair damaged ceiling tiles on all sites
  - Fix paving and eliminate trip hazards at EHS and AHS
  - Install concrete walkways in front of AHS and new concrete bike parking area on east side of AHS main building
  - Remove outdated 3-D map at EHS office door, refinish El Molino office sign
  - Repair leaks in irrigation going to rose garden at EHS bus circle
  - Install new District Office sign
  - Trim trees around AHS library
  - Dampen sound in AHS ceramics studio from wood shop exhaust motor
  - Repair hand rails in AHS main building
  - Replace damaged siding on LHS classrooms
  - Demolish Analy Nursery School portable and replace with used portable
  - Install two portables at AHS to accommodate growth
  - Field inspect and improve night lighting on all sites
