

Board Policy 5111.15

Students

ADMISSION – 5TH YEAR SENIORS

- A. Principals, or their specific designee(s) for this policy, may admit students for another year if they have not earned enough units to graduate at the end of four years.
- B. Principals have three options for enrolling such students:
 - 1. They may be enrolled unconditionally at Analy or El Molino, as appropriate.
 - 2. If they have had minor disciplinary, attendance, or other school-related problems, they may be enrolled “conditionally” – they may be placed on a probationary contract, but without any limitations as far as attending or participating in school activities.
 - 3. If they have had major disciplinary, attendance, or other school-related problems, they may be referred to Laguna, Russian River Ramparts, or Adult Education for possible enrollment.
- C. No district school is required to enroll, or maintain in enrollment, any student 18 years of age or older (except Special Education students).
- D. Notwithstanding section B above, in accordance with CIF regulations, 5th year students may not participate in interscholastic athletics.
- E. Enrolled 5ht year students will be counted as “other Enrollees” for CBEDS purposes.
