TRANSFER TO CONTINUATION EDUCATION

1. Involuntary transfer to continuation education shall be for a minimum of one full semester, voluntary transfers shall be for one full quarter minimum. Students may only return to the comprehensive high school at the beginning of the fall semester or the spring semester unless approved by the Superintendent or designee.
2. To return to the comprehensive high school, a student must apply at the continuation school and meet the following conditions at the continuation education school.
 - a. Involuntary Transfer – meet requirements in BP 5144.6 (A)(3) Prior Written Notice
 - b. Voluntary Transfer – meet requirement in BP 5144.6 (B)(1) Age of Student

3. New Students

Certain new students who were not placed in or who are not satisfactorily adjusting to a comprehensive high school may be placed in the continuation school. Students in this category are:

- a) Those who are placed in a continuation school of another district and who are not recommended by that district to return to a comprehensive high school.
- b) Those who are not placed in any school during the first five weeks of a semester.
- c) Those who are habitually truant, irregular in attendance or who have committed acts enumerated in E.C. 48900.
