CLASSIFICATION: Classified

TITLE OF IMMEDIATE SUPERVISOR: Supervisor of Maintenance & Operations

TITLE OF EVALUATOR: Principal or Vice Principal.

JOB SUMMARY: Under general supervision and working within a specified time limit, keep an assigned area of a building and grounds clean, sanitary and in safe condition; other related duties as assigned

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

- Sweep, dust, scrub, and mop floors; refinish, seal and wax floors of various types
- Dust and/or wash walls, woodwork, light fixtures, windows, blinds, furniture and other school equipment
- Vacuum and shampoo carpets
- Set up for athletic events
- Replace lamps and fuses
- Operate heating systems
- Open and secure District buildings and facilities

OTHER DUTIES:

- Make minor repairs and adjustments of furniture and equipment
- Perform minor painting and carpentry duties
- Repair lockers
- Move furniture

EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS:

• **Training and Experience** - One year experience in custodial work is desirable. Knowledge of: cleaning techniques, procedures and materials; safe work practices.

• **Abilities** - Ability to: use a variety of tools and equipment; work cooperatively with those contacted in the course of work; follow oral and written instructions.

• **Physical Effort/Working Environment** - Indoor and outdoor work environment during all seasons. Perform strenuous work, lift and carry up to 60 lbs., use of cleaning solvents/disinfectants common to custodial maintenance.

• **Licenses and Certifications** - A valid Class 3 California driver's license and evidence of appropriate automobile insurance based on DMV regulations may be required.

• **Education** - Completion of formal or informal education sufficient to assure the ability to read and write at the level required to perform the duties of the job safely and successfully.
